Organised in partnership with The Royal Australian Chemical Institute, The 1st Australian Materials Chemistry Conference (AMCC23) brings together experts from all subjects of materials chemistry and offers the materials chemistry community a highly visible platform to showcase their latest and new research. The conference covers a wide range of topics, including but not limited to biomaterials, functional soft materials and flexible devices (e.g. Electrical, magnetic, electrochemical, optical, and mechanical materials), emerging materials (e.g. Quantum, photonic and 2D materials), energy materials (e.g. Materials for catalysis, CO₂ reduction, batteries, hydrogen and solar energy conversion), materials computations (e.g. Machine learning, AI, DFT and molecular dynamic simulation and modelling), materials characterisation techniques and applications, materials for environment (e.g. environment protection, pollutants and toxic products treatment), and materials for industry, defense and space applications.

This two-day conference includes academic presentations, poster presentations and educational outreach that will attract international chemists, engineers, postgrads, domestic industrial participants, high school teachers/students and public audience, with an estimated 200 delegates.
