A. J. Birch Medal

The premier award of the Organic Chemistry Division of the RACI is the A. J. Birch Medal for excellence in organic chemical research conducted in Australia by a member of The RACI. One medal may be awarded at each National Meeting of the Division and the recipient shall normally be invited to present a paper to the National Meeting at which the award is made.

Nomination:

Nominations are submitted to the Chair of the Organic Division and should include the following information.

- Name and Curriculum Vitae (up to 3 pages)
- A concise statement of the nominee's contribution to research in organic chemistry in Australia (up to 250 words)
- A list of published research papers for the past 10 years, and of other publications (e.g. books, review chapters, etc.) relevant to the advancement of organic chemistry, without time restriction.

Nominations close in April and the recipient will be announced prior to the National Division Conference. The recipient shall normally be invited to present a paper to the National Meeting at which the award is made.
