

## **RACI Chemical Education Division Citations**

Nominations for a Division Citation should include the following information:

- Curriculum vitae (maximum 2 pages) including details of relevant dissemination or other evidence of impact related to chemical education such as relevant publications.
- A general statement of no more than 500 words addressing one or more the criteria listed below describing the nominee's contribution to chemical education in Australia that has had significant impact over at least a 2 year period within the past 10 years.

The sub-committee of the division take into account one or more of the following criteria in considering applications:

- Contribution to Australian chemical education in any context (secondary, tertiary or public engagement) evidenced by: impact on learning outcomes; delivery of evidence-based approaches to teaching; and/or promotion of teaching as a career.
- Development of teaching and learning resources (such as books, visual aids, interactive learning resources, online technologies/tools) that have been demonstrated as effective in learning and adopted by peers.
- The development of inclusive curricula and practices that widen participation in learning chemistry for traditionally underrepresented groups of students.
- Service to the Royal Australian Chemical Institute through leadership in mentoring or professional development of peers in Chemical Education.

This award will open annually at the beginning of April with a deadline on 1<sup>st</sup> Monday after June 30 each year. Please email nominations to the current CED Committee Chair.
