

### The Bruno Breyer Medal

The Breyer Medal and Lecture commemorates [Dr Bruno Breyer](#) (1900 – 1967) who was born in Czechoslovakia, educated in Germany, and later became a pioneer of AC polarography in Australia. The medal is awarded for internationally-recognized contributions in the field of electrochemistry
