

ARE YOU THE NEXT METROHM ANZ - EDRA CI 2020 YOUNG ELECTROCHEMIST WINNER?

In 2018, Metrohm celebrated its 75th Anniversary. On that occasion, Metrohm awarded several Young Chemist awards for outstanding researchers globally. Three young researchers from Australia & New Zealand (ANZ) were awarded the Metrohm Young Chemist title in 2018.

This year, [Metrohm ANZ](#) & the Electrochemistry Division of the Royal Australian Chemical Institute (EDRACI) are bringing back this award under the name of “Metrohm-EDRACI Young Electrochemist Award” to support Young Electrochemists in the ANZ region.

For the 2020 Young Electrochemist Award, there will be two award categories, and two winners will be selected from each category:

1. Higher degree by research (HDR)

HDR category (BSc/Hons/MSc/PhD) • \$500 Award for the winner • \$250 Award for the runner-up

2. Post-doctoral researcher

Post-doctoral category (up to 5 years post PhD at closing date of application) • \$500 Award for the winner • \$250 Award for the runner-up

A few rules:

• Higher degree by research includes BSc/Hons/MSc/PhD • Post-doctoral - limited to 5 years post PhD at closing date of application • Students/Researchers in Australia or New Zealand • Invitations are open for researchers in the Chemistry domain, preferably those using electrochemistry and/or spectroelectrochemistry techniques in their research (both applied and fundamental research) • Any other application formats (e.g. videos or ppt), should be stored on a shared drive (e.g. Dropbox, Google Drive, and OneDrive) and include the link in your PDF or Doc. application document.

Abstract submission should include: • Research title • Briefly describe the goal of your experiment, the experimental design and the methods of analysis you use • Discuss the impact of your results. Has the work been patented, published or used in conjunction with other research? • What are the next steps in this work? What will you or others do to advance your efforts? • What is the potential commercial impact of your work? • A short video presentation would be highly regarded.

Do not miss this opportunity to present your recent (within the last 2 years) research work to the distinguished panel of EDRA CI. This privileged platform has been designed to support and honour ongoing research activities and the great young aspiring minds who produce it.

Make sure to submit your research before Friday, 6 November, 2020 (5.00 pm AEDT) and all the best.
