Terms of Reference

The purpose

The purpose of the Chemical Education Committee is to oversee the chemical education activities of the RACI and report to the Board on the efficacy and strategic value of these activities. The remit of the Committee is different to that of the Chemical Education Division, although there may be some areas of overlap.

The Scope

The scope of activities covered by this Committee include, but are not limited to:

- The Australian National Chemistry Quiz (ANCQ)
- Titration competitions (both state based and national competitions)
- Crystal Growing competitions (both state based and national competitions)
- School outreach programs
- University outreach programs
- RACI Schools membership program
- Work with ASTA to ensure the schools outreach projects and resources provide what the teachers and students need.

Membership:

- Chair
- RACI Board member
- 8 Committee members representing both the secondary and tertiary education sectors

Appointment

- Appointment to the Committee is via nomination through the Chemical Education Committee Chair and appointment is made by the Board
- Persons appointed will have a 2-year term
- They may reapply once only for a further 2-years
- The Chair and/or Board reserves the right to remove any committee member who is deemed not to be active or contributing to the activities of the Chemical Education Committee
- All members who are unable to attend a meeting must notify the Chair of their absence

The Terms of Reference will be subject to annual review.
